Staff and Contractors

Good security starts with excellent people. All Grace staff are police-cleared, required to wear their uniform and display their photo ID card at all times, and must hold a current driver's licence. We also consult closely with your company's security advisor to develop procedures that ensure your high-security items are handled exactly how you want them to be. Our other security measures:

- We require employees to complete security awareness training on an annual basis
- We ask external service providers to sign a non-disclosure agreement before working with us
- We mandate that all visitors to Grace facilities sign in at reception and that a Grace employee accompany them at all times
- We enforce a pre-defined disciplinary process in the event of any breach of policy
- We immediately revoke network access when a staff member's employment is terminated
- We follow an Information Security
 Governance Framework that includes
 stringent security policies and procedures

Physical

Grace facilities are protected by electronic intruder detection systems with back-to-base alarms under 24-hour surveillance monitoring and CCTV recording. Each facility is surrounded by a two-metre-high electric fence monitored by a Titan electronic intruder detection system administered by an accredited security services provider. We also guarantee the security of your records with a range of internal systems and physical security measures:

- Physical security of records is ensured by restricted access to record storage areas
- Employee access to storage areas and records is on a needs-only basis
- Access is strictly controlled via our security doors, designated storage areas and the use of proximity cards
